



While the situation is rapidly changing, we are proceeding with our plans to run The MSS Safety Gorge RallySprint, taking all possible precautions to ensure everyone's safety. We will comply with MotorSport Australia's "Return to Race" guidelines and update our plans as new information comes to light.

Unlike many sporting events, a tarmac rally does not require individual personal contact. The driver and co-driver are the only people that are required to share a confined space – almost every other interaction can be done at a distance, online or in some other way that poses no risk.

Some of the steps we have in place are:

- Entries and payments will be done online
- All documentation will be done online
- Briefing materials will be available for download and sign off by competitors
- Hand sanitiser stations will be set up where appropriate
- Appropriate signage will be created where required
- Scrutiny will take place with precautions including
  - Set appointment times to eliminate gatherings of people
  - Scrutineers will wear appropriate PPE (gloves, masks as determined by medical advice)
  - Rallysafe devices to be fitted by Rallysafe officials following medical guidelines re PPE
- Public gatherings such as lunch and podium celebrations will undergo an assessment closer to the event
- Lunch may be take-away, with pre-packaged meals
- On-event communications will be done via SMS and Email
- Rallysafe timing will be utilised, no competitor time card will be required
- Communication to CRO's and Rally HQ, will be via phone, text or email

Of course, we will be guided by authorities should the situation change.

However, we are confident that appropriate action to safeguard public health is being undertaken by Government and that the worst of the pandemic limits will be over by the time the event is due to take place.

In difficult times, it is important to focus on the positives in our lives.

As the COVID-19 crisis eases, everyone will be keen to return to normality as quickly as possible and we are looking forward to delivering the MSS Safety Gorge RallySprint in a safe manner, and as much as possible bringing back the excitement and enjoyment of motorsport.

In the meantime, get out in the shed and keep working on your car!
