Frequently asked Questions Answered

| QUESTION | ANSWER |

| When do I have to have completed all details on my entry form? | Entry forms must be completed prior to the Close of Entries on Wednesday 26th August at 1800 hours. |
| When do I have to submit my documentation? | If you haven't lodged all your documents with Geraldine Hough 0431 306 015 geraldine.hough@bigpond.com by 6.00pm on the 12 th September, you will NOT be permitted to start the rally, and no refund will be made. |
| Is there an official Rally Guide for this event? | Yes, and it is a MUST read – there is lots of stuff you need to know. Get it here https://www.rallyofsa.com.au/events/gorge-rallysprint/ |
| Is the Rally Guide updated regularly? | Yes, check the website for the latest updated version which will be numbered and dated e.g. Rally Guide 26/06/20 |
| Can I get a refund if I withdraw before entries close? | An entry that is withdrawn at any time prior to 1800 hrs Wednesday August 26th (close of Entries) will be entitled to a refund of 100%. |
| Do I need to be at documentation? | NO, all entries and documentation will be done online. You MUST submit all documentation to the event Secretary GERALDINE HOUGH 0431 306 015 geraldine.hough@bigpond.com before the event as above |
| If I fail documentation or scrutineering can I get a refund? | Any Competitor or Crew who fails to complete documentation and/or scrutiny shall be refused permission to start and the Entry Fee will not be refunded. |
| Will there be a driver briefing? | All briefing materials will be available for download and sign off via Geraldine Hough. No sign off by competitors = no start, and no refund will be made. |
| Does my car have to be scrutineered? | All cars will require to be scrutineered one at a time as per a schedule to be published, with social distancing maintained. |
| Can I get regionally scrutineered? | Yes, regional scrutineering is allowed, but ONLY by direct arrangement with the Chief Scrutineer BEN AFFORD on 0407 793 991. |
| Can I get a refund if I withdraw before scrutineering? | An entry that is withdrawn at any time after August 26th close of entries, but prior to 1000 hrs Sunday September 6th (Scrutiny) will be entitled to a refund of 70%. |
| My car has been scrutineered, but I need to withdraw. Can I still get a refund? | An entry that is withdrawn after Scrutiny and before 1200 hrs Saturday September 12th, 2020 shall be entitled to a refund of 50%. |
| Do I need a personal COVID kit in my rally car? | Yes, and it needs to have gloves and face masks for the driver and co-driver, but NO hand sanitiser. There will be BOTT Group COVID CARE KITS at all control points, the Service Park, The Tavern, and at Rally HQ. |

| Will there be any COVID19 related checks? | You will be required to undergo a test for body temperature at scrutineering and at entry to the Service Park. For further advice see https://www.covid-19.sa.gov.au/health-advice/stop-the-spread-in-sa |
| What are the rules around Recce? | Reconnaissance is MANDATORY for all competing crews. A minimum of 1 pass and a maximum of 3 passes over each stage for all competing crews is allowed. |
| What happens if I am caught speeding during Recce? | You will be referred to the event officials and may be excluded from the rally. No refund will be made. |
| Can I be near another competitor's team at the Service Park? | Yes. BETH BAILEE is the Chief Official at the Service Park. Notify her of any such requirements on 0452 462 011 and she will do her best to accommodate you. |
| Will there be parking for trailers in the Service Park? | Yes, but it will be very limited. Our preference is that you do not bring any trailers. |
| Can I refuel in the service park? | Yes, but only in the designated area from fuel that you have placed there. |
| Will there be any tyre trucks in the Service Park? | Yes. SA MotorSport Tyres are planning to be there. See Rally Guide for details. Contact Mark Povey 0409 288 380. |
| How many people can I bring into the service park as part of my team? | A total of 8 people from your team are allowed. This includes the Driver, Co-Driver and service crew members. This may change pending circumstances at the time. |
| Do we need to wear masks and gloves in the Service Park? | No. Your call. However, you need to maintain social distancing and follow the directions of officials. |
| Will there be food at the Service Park? | Yes, pre-packaged competitor lunches are included in the entry fee. Other breakfasts and lunches are available on order. |
| Do I need to order my lunch? | Sorry, no mind readers here 😊 so PLEASE PRE-ARRANGE ALL ORDERS with Karen at the Tavern on 0412 654 049 by 12 noon on Thursday 10 September to allow for adequate catering. |
| Will coffee and snacks be available? | The Cudlee Creek Tavern will be open, serving coffee, drinks and snacks and is a short walk from the Service Park. |

| Will vegetarian or other special food requirements be catered for? | There is one vegetarian option for lunch, as per the menu published in the Rally Guide. Special dietary, vegan etc is NOT, so you will need to BYO. |
| Can I buy food from the Cudlee creek Tavern? | Yes. The Tavern is offering food package kits for Sunday Breakfast and Lunch Just call ahead (see above) and order or visit the Tavern prior to the event to order your packs. |
| Will I have a road card, and will I have to hand it to control officials? | No. The event will be using RallySafe for all timing and check-ins. A competitor record card for you to take notes and record your own details will be provided in the rally box. |
| What official timing is used? | 100% of the event will use RallySafe and no road cards will be required to avoid person to person contact. All timing and messaging will be IN CAR through RallySafe. |
| How do I know my stage time? | RallySafe will display it automatically when you cross the flying finish line. |
| Do I need to stop at the finish control? | Yes, you must stop for safety reasons, and to get back into liaison mode - but not to touch or share any items with officials. |
| What happens if I need to get out of the vehicle and approach another competitor who has had an accident? | You must maintain social distancing, however if medical assistance is required you must wear your mask and gloves and keep them on always. MIVs will attend as required and tasked. |
| What happens if I am caught speeding during liaisons on event? | You will be referred to the event officials and may be excluded from the rally. |
| Where is Rally HQ? | At the Soldiers Memorial Hall across the road from the Tavern. You have no need to go there – all communication is to be strictly via the CROs (COMPETITOR RELATIONS OFFICERS). |
| How will communications between competitors and officials occur? | General on-event communications will be done via phone, text and email only. Be sure to have lodged all relevant email addresses with us. |
| Will there be a re-group and if so, how will that work? | Yes, there may be regroupings during the event. You will need to remain in your vehicle for the full duration of any regroup, unless absolutely necessary to be out of the car. Social distancing applies. |
| I am from a media organisation and I want to come to the MSS Safety Gorge RallySprint, how do I arrange it? | Media Credentials are essential for access and are available via Media Manager WAYNE HOUGH. Call him on 0448 889 000 to arrange. Media Vests will be required. NO VEST = NO ACCESS. |

| If I am excluded or withdraw during the event can I still get a refund? | During the Event, if any Entrant is excluded or withdraws for any reason, there is no entitlement to a refund of any payments made. |
| Can I have any alcoholic drinks at the event? | All Motorsport Australia events require ZERO alcohol be maintained always. Authorised Testing Officers may be present, and random testing is always probable. Don't risk it – be ZERO. |
| Can I spectate at the MSS Safety Gorge RallySprint? | Yes, but only within SA state COVID19 guidelines applicable at the time. No "official" points will be published. |
| Will the awards be available at the end of the rally? | Yes, but these will not be physically handed out - all awards will be available for pick up after the event. There will not be a formal podium – and a gathering only if SA state guidelines allow it. |
| Will there be a post event function? | It will depend on what restrictions are in play at the time. You will be advised closer to the event. |
