- **ROAD CLOSURE OFFICIAL**

Am I required to provide a road closure official?



Yes.

All competitors are required to provide one person to act as a road closure official for at least one stage at the event.

This cannot be an already registered person, but someone unique to you, nominated by you. What we are asking for is at least 1 “new” person to do just 1 road closure on the weekend.

Friend of a friend? Family? Friends who are curious? Competitors who no longer compete? Member of Service Crew?

- **RALLY BOXES**

These contain your sticker roll and numbers, and lots of other bits and pieces.

The competitor Rally Boxes will be posted to each interstate entrant's nominated address after close of entries.

Entrants must nominate an address where someone is present to sign for the Rally Box – a work address is ideal for security of delivery reasons. This includes entrants from Mount Gambier and Port Lincoln

Local SA entrants will be able to pick up their boxes by arrangement ONLY, from 0900 hrs on Tuesday, April 23rd to 1630 hrs on Wednesday April 24th

Remember, all cars must be presented all stickered up, ready to rally. They may be randomly checked by Scrutineers

- **DAMAGE**

If you damage any fences or private property it is a requirement that you report it at the next Stop Control and to Rally HQ. A reminder that as per Motorsport Australia insurance policy you are liable for the first \$10,000 of any damage to property.

- **SATELLITE TIMING - TIME CARDS (to be supplied)**

1. The Time Cards are for your reference only.
2. Rally Time is on your RallySafe Unit.
3. The Officials use Tablets and will send the Start Time to your Unit.

4. The Times you have at Controls will automatically be sent through to the Results Team via Satellite.
5. The Start Line is a GPS Point. Penalties for Jump Start will still apply, RallySafe knows the moment you start moving. No wheelspin
6. Please ensure you STOP at the Stop Control; they will quickly write down the Stage Time for a backup or may ask you about a missing competitor on stage.

- **SOCIAL EVENTS**

There are **several arranged social "events"** for you to participate in

- 1 The **Event Breakfast** on Saturday Morning, from 7-ish am. Each driver and co-driver will have a free ticket – See me or Nancye for your tickets - all others pay \$15 per head direct to the caterers. This will be carried out by Members of the BURRA COMMUNITY SCHOOL and is a fund raiser for them.
- 2 On the Sunday Afternoon, there will be a **light lunch** at the Hallett Refuel – provided by members of the Burra Golf Club – Each driver and co-driver will have a free ticket plus any purchased ones - more info to come
- 3 On Sunday night, following the podium, there is a **Post Event Party** at the Paxton Square Chapel from about 5pm to 8.30pm. Each driver and co-driver will have a free ticket (plus any other pre-purchased ones) See Nancye for your tickets – all others pay \$25 per head direct to the caterers. More information and how to get tickets etc will be coming soon
