

Drivers Briefing 2024

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

The road book for this event has been created based on providing instructions that enable crews to traverse the course.

It has been carefully prepared, and independently checked and approved by MA, using non- competitive vehicles at relatively low speeds. A "hummingbird" GPS measuring device was used to measure distances.

The instructions in the road book are our interpretation of the course. They may not contain some items that you consider to be hazards, and they may not contain items that become a hazard.

The special stages and liaisons traverse a range of public roads. Animals, both wild and domestic, may be found on the course during the event. In addition, the course may contain changes in direction, and/or surface, which may not be in the instructions.

Accordingly, we advise crews that they are totally responsible for the manner and speed in which they traverse the course, and ultimately their own safety. Crews should be taking their own experience and abilities into account, and so traverse the course in the manner and speed at which they are comfortable.

REMEMBER - MOTOR SPORT IS DANGEROUS - DRIVE ACCORDING TO WHAT YOU CAN SEE.

- There is NO pump fuel available at the Service Park.
- There is fuel available at OTR Tanunda and MOGAS Cockatoo Valley
- There is to be no refuelling in the Service Park

Service Crews are free to refuel cars at other locations on the rally route excluding on Special Stages.

Apparel Checks

MIV Crew will check at the Start of each stage Items checked include Helmets done up **Driving Suits worn and** done up Seat Belts done up **Headlights On** FHR



2024 SAFETY APPAREL CHECK

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ALL Competitors are required to wear the following.

Safety Helmet, Balaclava", Driving Suits, Seat Belts (Firm) Frontal Head Restraints. (FHR) and Gloves (Driver Only).

- If you stop on a stage due to accident or breakdown you must warn following crews;
- OK / SOS Sign is in the Rally Box;
- If you are OK display your "OK" sign;
- If you need help display your "SOS" sign;
- In either case you need to place your warning triangles out;
 - First one 50 metres back from your car
 - Second one 100 metres back from your car

- First Car is to stop if "SOS" sign or no Sign displayed and render assistance, including placing warning triangles if not already done;
- Second Car is to stop and gather details and move off to the end of stage (not the flying finish);
- Third Car is to stop and gather details and move off to the end of stage (not the flying finish) as a back-up to the second car;

- Second & Third cars are to try and establish mobile phone contact with Rally Control as they are moving;
- Remember if there is no "OK" or "SOS" then you must stop;
- Remember if you don't put your "OK" sign out when you are OK there may be some unhappy drivers who stop to assist;

If you pass a vehicle with "OK" sign out then you may continue at competition speed but advise the Stop Control of the location on the stage of the vehicle;

Vehicles that stop to assist a vehicle will be given a derived time for the stage.

Mobile Phones

Essential Part of the Tracking System When you start a Stage turn them OFF When you finish a Stage turn them back ON If you breakdown or crash in a Stage then turn them back ON if you can, as Rally Control will attempt to contact you

Removal of Persons from Vehicle

If there is no risk of fire or other danger then leave the people in the vehicle until the MIV arrives

If there is a danger of further injury then remember that you will require a lot of assistance to move someone out of a car particularly if it is upside down

Helmet Removal

- Only remove helmet if it is causing injury or breathing blockage
- Procedure one person supports the head as the helmet is removed by another person

Fire Extinguisher Use

Fire Extinguishers

- Will pack down over time particularly when in a vehicle due to constant vibration
- Invert your extinguisher before you start to ensure the powder is not packed down
- If you have a plastic bracket replace it with a metal one

Removing a Pin

- Twist the pin to snap the tie
- Pull out the pin



Fire Extinguisher Use



Under Bonnet Fire

- One person to be with the extinguisher ready
- Other person to lift the bonnet slightly
- Squirt the powder in through the gap in a sweeping motion
- Small squirt then let the powder settle
- Continue with short squirts every 10-15 seconds
- A 1 kg extinguisher will last 20 seconds if you get trigger lock but can last a couple of minutes with short squirts
- Remember your nearest backup extinguishers are in the following car which may be 2-5 minutes away

Stage Stopped Form

If an MIV enters a Stage and passes you stopped on the side of the road it will give you a Stage Stopped Form

The MIV has entered the Stage and the Stage stopped for some form of incident on the Stage



Stage Stopped Form

You may proceed through the Stage if you can, but at reduced speed and on the LEFT HAND SIDE of the road

You may encounter Emergency Vehicles travelling against Rally direction



STAGE STOPPED

STAGE YELLOW OR RED

THIS FORM IS TO BE HANDED BY THE MIV CREW TO COMPETITORS WHO HAVE STOPPED ON A SPECIAL STAGE.

THIS SPECIAL STAGE HAS BEEN STOPPED DUE TO AN INCIDENT, MISSING COMPETITOR, UNSAFE SPECTATORS ON THE STAGE OR SOME OTHER PROBLEM.

YOU ARE CLEAR TO PROCEED ALONG THE STAGE AT SLOW SPEED, IN RALLY DIRECTION, BUT ONLY ON THE **LEFT HAND SIDE** OF THE ROAD.

BE READY TO STOP IF REQUIRED.

EMERGENCY VEHICLES MAY BE TRAVELING TOWARDS YOU AGAINST THE DIRECTION OF RALLY TRAFFIC.

YOU MUST STOP IF SIGNALLED BY AN OFFICIAL OF THE EVENT.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES ARE YOU TO TRAVEL AT RALLY SPEED OR AGAINST THE DIRECTION OF RALLY TRAFFIC.

TIMES FOR THE STAGE WILL BE EITHER DELETED OR DERIVED TIMES GIVEN.
